If you are creative and enjoy art, this course will open your eyes to the profession of an artist.

For three days and two nights you will have the opportunity to work in residence like an artist, focused on your creativity. You will have plenty of help to improve and learn new skills, as well as time to independently experiment and develop ideas. You will be given the knowledge and understanding needed to refine your techniques with creative flair, and together explore the story (concept) of your artwork and the work of other artists. This will lead to an exhibition of artwork and sketchbook designs for exhibition.

Throughout the course you will be supported by experienced tutors and teachers in Secondary education, who are also artists. They will help you to develop and complete your own piece of work for exhibition. You will then be able to take this work away with you to show your school, family and friends.

### As a result of coming on this course you will:

- Experience a strong sense of achievement
- Develop your confidence and learn new techniques
- Practice and improve your visual art skills across a range of media
- Meet new, like-minded, friends
- Receive a certificate of attendance
- Exhibit your work
